## **CIVIC BEAUTIFICATION COMMITTEE 2023**

The president will appoint a community donation chair at the beginning of their terms. The chair will appoint members to assist in organizing projects and enlisting volunteers that will promote the Port Angeles Garden Club and improve and beautify our community.

## Civic beautification committee responsibilities:

- Work with city partners in establishing projects that will benefit the city in the form of beautification or improvements.
- Coordinate projects selected with the city and the garden club to ensure the goal of the project, time, place, materials needed, volunteers needed will be ready to start and complete the project.
- Establish a calendar of events.
- Contact publicity chair for promotion of events with media.
- Complete committee report for future committees to use for reference.
- Communicate with the awards committee for possible awards that are available for these projects. Awards available are - Civic Development; Legislation, Operation Wildflower; Blue Star Memorial; Youth education, nature programs, workshops; Natural Disasters Restoration; Historic Trails Restoration to name a few.

## Current projects:

- 1. Clallam County Fair Baskets
  - a. Baskets, pots, soil, fertilizer and plants are provided by the club. The planting process will be scheduled by the committee chair.
  - b. Club members volunteer to plant and care for the planters until they are delivered to the fair for display.
  - c. The baskets are returned to the volunteer that cared for them to enjoy after the fair and get them ready for the next fair.
  - d. If the volunteer wishes to give their basket back at the end of the fair, the committee chair will enlist the help of another club member to care for until the next fair.
- 2. Port Angeles Parks and Recreation Department Assistance
  - a. The chair will be in contact with the parks and recreation department regarding the city flower boxes, baskets and Billy Loos Garden.
  - b. The committee will enlist volunteer club members to assist with the process of planting the downtown basket (April) and flower boxes (May) according to the city's schedule.
  - c. Billy Loos garden was started by a PAGC member and has continued to be cared for by the club in her memory.
  - d. The PAGC is also in charge of maintaining the Blue Star Marker, the Gold Star Marker and the Veteran's Memorial Park on Lincoln street.
