

YOUTH EDUCATION COMMITTEE 2023

The president will appoint a youth education committee chair at the beginning of their terms. The chair will select 3-5 committee members to assist with their responsibilities. The objective of this committee is to educate youth about gardening and its importance in the area of conservation, food supply, relaxation, etc.

Youth committee responsibilities:

- Coordinate with area schools, clubs and families to sponsor or guide activities for youth.
- Encourage club members to be engaged with the various youth organizations the committee has contacted. This is not limited to helping with activities and educating the youth about the objective of the youth committee.
- Keep records of all contacts made to the various youth organizations and schools to have meaningful discussions about the needs of their groups and how the Port Angeles Garden club can assist with those needs.
- Record all visitations and interactions with the contacts made at the various projects. This should include any correspondence, pictures, signs and notes from the youth.
- The chair shall attend all board meetings and propose a budget by July 31.
- The youth education committee will be put on the agenda of the general meeting when there is an update on any projects they are working on.
- Coordinate with the publicity committee any information about current projects they are working on with the youth in our area.
